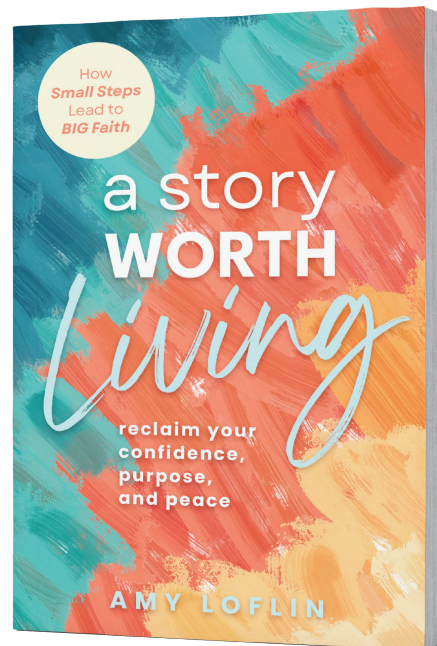

# Suggested Interview Questions

Rather than covering everything broadly, I've found the most meaningful conversations happen when we choose one or two areas to go deeper. A range of possible questions and themes are shared below; I'm happy to follow your lead and tailor the conversation to best serve your audience. Please let me know in advance which questions you plan to explore.



## Book + Core Message

- What inspired you to write *A Story Worth Living*?
- Why did you choose the bleeding woman's encounter with Jesus as the central focus of the book?
- What do you hope a reader experiences as she moves through this story?

## Closing + Big Picture

- Why did you choose the title *A Story Worth Living*?
- What do you hope shifts in a woman's life after reading this book?

## Themes from the Book (choose one to go deeper):

### Body + Identity

So many women struggle with their relationship with their bodies. Why was it important for you to include this topic, and what do you hope women take away?

### Shame + Forgiveness

Many women carry a deep sense of shame. What has your own story taught you about the role of forgiveness in breaking that cycle?

### Suffering + View of God

How does prolonged suffering shape the way we see God—and how can that perspective be restored?

### Coming Out of Hiding (Luke 8:47)

The moment the woman "could no longer stay hidden" is so powerful. Why do you think so many women can relate?

### Surface Faith vs Deep Connection

You explore the phrase "deep calls to deep." Why do you think it's so easy for us to stay on the surface, and what helps us move into deeper connection with God?

### Transformation + Application

How did immersing yourself in this story change the way you see and interact with others?

What does this story teach us about compassion and Christian sisterhood?

### Key Scripture Insight

Jesus tells her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace." What stands out to you most about this moment when we slow down and really consider it?
